ORDINANCE 92-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AMENDING SECTION 10.12.100 OF THE HOMER CITY CODE, (PORT AND HARBOR) RELATIVE TO FEES.

WHEREAS, the Port and Harbor Commission has submitted various recommendations to offset Harbor expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 91-25 was adopted by the Homer City Council on the 25th of November, 1991; and

WHEREAS, upon review by the Port and Harbor Commission it was determined that there should be a surcharge for all passengers and not just those on crew ships.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HOMER ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 10.12.100 (d) of the Homer City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

d. All passengers of commercial vessels entering or departing the harbor ~~{Vessels with a capacity in excess of eighty passengers}~~ shall pay a ~~fee of two dollars for each passenger disembarking, either directly, by shuttle or lighter, at the launch ramp}~~ surcharge of one dollar during the period May 15 to September 15 of each year. The Harbormaster shall provide forms to be used by the vessel operators in logging passenger traffic ~~{off-loading at the ramp}~~ and such completed forms shall be submitted with the appropriate fee to the Harbormaster.
