ORDINANCE 92-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER PROVIDING FOR AN ADVISORY VOTE AT THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION CONCERNING THE FUNDING OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS:

WHEREAS; The City of Homer is facing a substantial revenue shortfall, and:

WHEREAS; The Council of the City of Homer desires to conduct the affairs of the City in a fiscally prudent manner, and:

WHEREAS; The Council of the City of Homer desires to reflect the priorities of the Voters, to the greatest extent practical, and:

WHEREAS; An advisory vote of the people is an appropriate vehicle for the expression of those priorities;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF HOMER HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The following ballot shall be presented to the voters at the next regular election:
