


# Homer Public Library's Western Lot

## Site Analysis and Concept Ideas

**Programming:**  
 Key to this concept is the development of side trails in order to increase access and provide routes for *story trails*. The intent of this network of trails is to provide a variety of options for how the *story trail* concept could be implemented. The concept also provides areas that would be used for current and future library programming such as story hour. A few different sizes of spaces are envisioned to allow flexibility for group size and program opportunities. Another important aspect is to develop the space to increase its use by the general public. In addition to expanding the library usership through interaction with site programming, increased use will have the added benefit of an increased level of passive and active observation for the site.
