7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER,
8 ALASKA, AWARDING A CONTRACT TO PACIFIC PILE
9 AND MARINE, LP, OF SEATTLE, WASHINGTON, IN AN
10 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000 FOR FENDER PILE
11 REMOVAL AT THE DEEP WATER DOCK AND
12 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
13 APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

15 WHEREAS, The corner fenders on the City's Deep Water Dock were again damaged
16 during a storm in October 2012, removal of the piling and fenders is necessary to protect the
17 dock from damage; and

18
19 WHEREAS, Port and Harbor personnel contacted three contractors (per procurement
20 policy) and Pacific Pile and Marine was the only contractor able to respond; and

21
22 WHEREAS, The cost of the required work cannot be reasonably anticipated and a time
23 and material contract is appropriate and in the best interest of the City; and



25 WHEREAS, This proposed award is not final until written notification is received by
26 Pacific Pile and Marine, LP from the City of Homer.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska,
29 approves the award of the removal of damaged fenders and piling at the Deep Water Dock to
30 Pacific Pile and Marine, LP, of Seattle, Washington, in the amount not to exceed \$25,000; and
31 authorizes the City Manager to execute the appropriate documents to complete construction.
