9 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
10 EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE HOMER PLAYGROUND  
11 PROJECT PROPOSAL TO CONSTRUCT A NEW  
12 PLAYGROUND AT KAREN HORNADAY PARK DURING A  
13 "BUILD WEEK" SCHEDULED FOR MAY 21-27, 2012, AND  
14 ENCOURAGING COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION.

16 WHEREAS, The Homer Playground Project (HoPP) was established by community  
17 members last spring to raise funds and mobilize volunteers to replace the old playground at  
18 Karen Hornaday Park with a new and more diverse playground; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, HoPP has engaged the services of a professional playground design firm  
21 and produced a schematic design that reflects input from hundreds of Homer children and adults  
22 and has been approved by the Karen Hornaday Park Committee; and



24 WHEREAS, In consultation with the playground designer, the City of Homer Public  
25 Works Director, and private contractors; HoPP has determined that May 21-27, 2012, is the  
26 optimum time for "Build Week," during which time the playground will be built by volunteers  
27 with professional supervision; and

29 WHEREAS, HoPP has already raised \$60,608, including \$5,000 provided by the City of  
30 Homer Ordinance 11-27 and is working hard to raise funds, recruit volunteers, and solicit  
31 donations of tools and materials that will be needed to achieve this goal.



34 hereby supports the Homer Playground Project timeline that calls for May 21-27, 2012 to be  
35 designated as "Build Week"; and urges community members of all ages to participate in this
